Central University announces the opening of the application for academic exchange for Faculty and Students with Çankırı Karatekin University within the scope of Erasmus+ mobility exchange program for the **2022-2023** academic year starting from **20th** February 2023 to 26th June 2023

- Art and Design MA Programme (Master Degree)

SELECTION & EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR STAFF TEACHING MOBILITY

Applicants will be awarded points and the actual and substitute Erasmus participants will be selected based on the superiority of their scores.

1. Number of participation. 40 points for first time beneficiaries of Erasmus KA107 Program; 20 points for second time beneficiaries, 10 points for third time beneficiaries,

5 points for fourth time beneficiaries; and no points for the fifth time or above beneficiaries will be given.

2. Foreign language. 25% of the Foreign Language Exam Score is taken in the calculation (TOEFL or IELTS scores or any valid foreign language exams in your university; the calculation is done based on 100 full points. Please check this page for the official equivalents of the TOEFL and IELTS scores: <https://dokuman.osym.gov.tr/pdfdokuman/2016/GENEL/EsdegerlikTablosu25022016.pdf>). No points will be given to the ones who do not submit their official foreign language exam result. Having at least **55 points** is the prerequisite for the application.

The content of the Teaching Agreement is expected to be authentic and relevant with the area of specialization. The department of the applicants and of the university they will be going to should have similar qualifications. The Teaching Agreement must be uploaded to the system; otherwise, the application will not be taken into consideration. The teaching agreement must be filled in English and its upload to the system is the prerequisite for the evaluation. Other scores of those who do not get a minimum of **5 points** from the teaching agreement will not be taken into account.

The commission evaluates the scientific appropriateness of the mobility in its framework; however, it is not possible to make a detailed academic/scientific evaluation which requires specialization. The commission evaluates all the mobility applications by handling it as a whole; and considering different criteria such as the internationalization strategy of the national agency and our university, its potential benefit to the international identity and improvement of our university, and the vision of the applicability of the teaching/training agreements.

Note: Getting a minimum of **50 points** in total is a prerequisite to benefit from the mobility.

SELECTION & EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR STAFF TRAINING MOBILITY

Applicants will be awarded points by prioritizing the following conditions and the actual and substitute Erasmus participants will be selected based on the superiority of their scores.

3. Number of participation. 40 points for first time beneficiaries of Erasmus KA107 Program; 20 points for second time beneficiaries, 10 points for third time beneficiaries, 5 points for fourth time beneficiaries; and no points for the fifth time or above beneficiaries will be given.
4. Foreign language. 25% of the Foreign Language Exam Score is taken in the calculation (TOEFL or IELTS scores or any valid foreign language exams in your university; the calculation is done based on 100 full points. The department of the applicant and of the university he/she will be going to should have similar qualifications. The Training Agreement must be uploaded to the system; otherwise, the application will not be taken into consideration. The training agreement must be filled in English and its upload to the system is the prerequisite for the evaluation. Other scores of those who do not get a minimum of **5 points** from the training agreement will not be taken into account.

The commission evaluates the scientific appropriateness of the mobility in its framework; however, it is not possible to make a detailed academic/scientific evaluation, which requires specialization. The commission evaluates all the mobility applications by handling it as a whole; and considering different criteria such as the internationalization strategy of the national agency and our university, its potential benefit to the international identity and improvement of our university, and the vision of the applicability of the teaching/training agreements.

Note: Getting a minimum of **50 points** in total is a prerequisite to benefit from the mobility.

SELECTION & EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR STUDENT STUDY MOBILITY

- Students must have satisfactorily completed their 1st year at the University for both undergraduate and post-graduate students
- Minimum GPA for undergraduate students is 2.20/4.00 (58/100) and for graduate students is 2.50/4.00 (65/100)
- The students will be selected by taking the account of their GPA (%50) and their relevant Language Proficiency Test (%50)
- Students are supposed to plan full-time activity, which is equal to 30 ECTS per semester.
- On their return, all succeeded courses at the host university will be recognised by the sending university and will be considered as part of Exchange students' mainstream education, and will be counted within the the number of total credits they are expected to collect for graduation from their home institution.

The result of the language exam of the administrative staff applying for the mobility of training must be at least 50 points out of 100. Applicants should either take the Erasmus Foreign Language Exam or prove their foreign language proficiency with a document. Applications must be submitted via our online system to the International Relations Unit by the deadline for application.

Selection Procedure

The selection procedure is done according to the criteria provided under each category of mobility. The application documents are checked by the International Relations Office first and then evaluated by the Staff Mobility Evaluation Commission and Rectorate. Commission results are submitted to the Rectorate for approval, and the applications approved by the Rectorate are announced on the website.

Acceptance & Invitation Letter

Acceptance or invitation letters will be requested by the International Relations Unit.

Erasmus Grant

The grant include 820 euro for flight tickets no more or less for both staff and one student, 140 euro * 5 working days =700 + 820 euro for one staff.

For the selected student; 800 euro for one month and in total 106 days. 2,880 + 820 euro for one term.

Students will be accepted for only one term nearly 4-month time. However, the grant does not cover the second week of the finals.

Grant Payment

70% of the grant will be paid within 2 weeks after signing the grant contract. The remaining 30% of the grant will be paid after the completion of the activity and the documents to be submitted. (**For students**)

All grant payments are calculated by the International Relations Office according to the budget of the KA171 Project which has been approved by the National Agency.

NOTE FOR OUTGOING STAFF

Staff will be responsible for all living expenses including transportation to and from CAKU, room and board, HEALTH INSURANCE and miscellaneous expenses while at CAKU. Although CAKU has a health center where incoming staff can see a doctor and have simple blood tests done, staff must have an emergency/hospitalization insurance valid in Turkey for further health complications.

- a. Staff will agree to abide by the rules and regulations of Cankiri Karatekin University.
- b. The Erasmus grant is going to be paid on Friday %100 if the activities are completed.
